Looking for a great night out on your doorstep? The Musical **West Side Story** is coming to **Madley Park Hall**. Twenty students (aged 14-24) have been rehearsing for 2½ month to bring this exciting and dynamic production to Witney. The hall was chosen as a rehearsal and performance venue because the new building has a well-proportioned internal space with good parking as a bonus. This is WARTS second production, within 4 or 5 months of their Pantomime Sinbad and the Diamond Princess, which was their inaugural event in December last year. They've also done an open mike talent show where a lot of local Witney talent took part. WARTS is looking to expand its educational programme to include a younger and older drama group who meet weekly at Madley Park Hall. Any potential performers, who would be interested in joining this group, will need to attend a formal audition and if successful, pay a termly subscription. This membership would include access to professional workshops in dance, drama and singing; open mike nights with judges, public performances and full productions. WARTS aim is to do two new productions a year. **West Side Story shows will run for three nights at Madley Park Hall, Fri 21st, Sat 22nd and Sun 23rd 7.30pm start, with doors opening at 7 pm.
